WHAT TO DO IF YOU WANT TO COME TO INSTITUTE OF GEOLOGICAL SCIENCES AS A ERASMUS+ STUDENT?

Recruitment for Erasmus+ students

Student who applies for studies at each of the three levels of studies (Bachelor, Master's and PhD) or traineeships at the Institute of Geological Sciences at the University of Wrocław (ING UWr) is kindly asked to choose appropriate courses from the list of available <u>classes</u> and <u>traineeships</u> and include them in Learning Agreement (LA).

The preliminary LA must be submitted for approval to coordinator in the ING UWr, <u>Magdalena Matusiak-Małek</u>. After acceptance, the LA needs to be uploaded to the Erasmus+ system (available at student's home university web page)

Later, when already in place student can make changes to LA, that is also dependent on the choices of other students of the Erasmus+ group and availability in particular semester. The changes to LA have to be accepted by coordinators as well of host as home institution.

Before each semester a 2-week <u>preparatory course of Polish</u> organize by the School of Polish Language and Culture for Foreigners takes place. A 100% attendance is granted with 3 ECTS.

Moreover, selecting a semester Polish language course student gains 6 ECTS.
